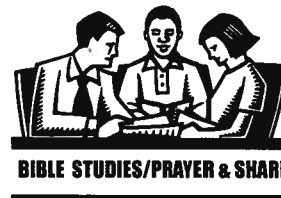

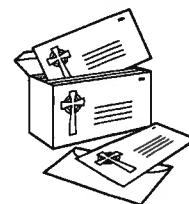

**April's Noisy Offering -
Life Source**



LifeSource is the Organ Procurement Organization serving Minnesota, North Dakota and South Dakota. They work with 300 hospitals and 9 transplant centers relentlessly pursuing a day where everyone in need of a life-saving organ transplant gets one.

The number of donors grows every year. In 2024 there was a 1% increase with 258 people giving the gift of life. 874 organs were transplanted and there were 969 Musculoskeletal (tissue) donors.

There are 100,000 people on the national transplant waiting list hoping for that life-saving organ. In our 3 state area 2600 are waiting as nationally a new name is added every 7.5 min.

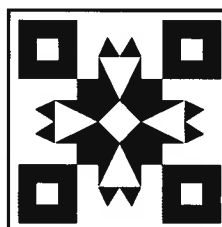
1 organ donor can save 8 lives and help more than 75 people with their tissue donation. 1 donor can also restore sight to 2 people.

How can you help? Sign up today to be an organ donor upon your death. You can mark it on your driver's license or when getting a hunting or fishing license. You can also register online at Life-source.org. or even on your phone in the Health App! Most importantly have the conversation with your family about your wishes, so if something unfortunate were to happen your family knows what you wanted? Families struggle when they are wondering what their loved one would want in these moments of shock and grief.

You can also be a living donor by donating a kidney or part of your liver to someone waiting on the transplant list. If the person you are hoping to help is not a match you can be part of the Paired Exchange Program. You donate to someone in the nation who you do match and someone in the nation who matches with your recipient then gets their kidney or liver. Like a 3 way trade!

"If you had the chance to save someone else's life, why wouldn't you do it?" Sign up to be a donor, save a life!

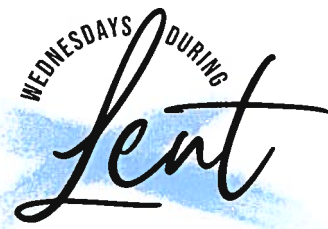
