I'm flustered as I write ... many "to-dos" before I head out-of-town for a quick overnight. A bride planned her wedding around my schedule – next to the groom, it's important for her to have me standing in front officiating the service.

When I agreed months ago, my calendar didn't look as messy as it does now. A quick getaway has become the "one more thing" I dread. I know, once I see Sonja walking down the aisle, I'll be emotional with joy and gratitude.

Of my many faults, I recognize how easily I get stirred up – forgetting to take a step back and breathe. I wasn't always this way; it's one of the changes within me I'm rebelling against.

To help calm me down, I found the "5 Senses Exercise". To exercise, one simply notices:

- 5 things you can see
- 4 things you can touch
- 3 things you can hear
- 2 things you can smell
- 1 thing you can taste.

I've done this, and by the time I get to "1", whatever had me worked up, felt more like a minor annoyance. My perspective changed and I found myself buoyant with appreciation and thanksgiving. I saw ... and see ... more of God and less of what "stirs" me up.

Here's one example of my list:

- 5 yellow leaves, an American flag, a sunrise, birds at the feeder, school bus
- 4 holding Becki's hand, my dog, soft quilt, socks
- 3 loud alarm clock, Confirmation kids, laughter
- 2 someone's fireplace, Pinesol
- 1 apple crisp

We're reminded in Psalm 34, "Taste and see that the LORD is good". If we'd only take the time ...

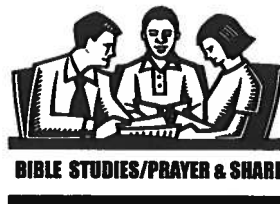

# Grace Lutheran Church Minutes - 10/9/24



**Grace Members Present:** Danielle Anderson, Don Bakken, Eric Johnson, Erin Okerlund, Clem Roers, Brenda Trisko, Coley Wagner. **Guests Present:** Pastor Bradley Pearson, Kelli Wendel, Steffen Morical.

We opened with prayer. Eric called the meeting to order. Welcomed Steffen to the meeting; he will be joining council next year as VP.

Coley motioned to approve the agenda. Brenda 2nd. Approved.

**VISITOR REPORTS:** None

**PASTORAL REPORT:** Pastor Brad spoke to the challenge of inspiring people to step up and serve in a variety of roles. We are seeing many of the same people continue to serve, and he is concerned about "wear and tear" as many of these individuals are getting older. Asked for council to be aware of this trend and to be looking forward to how we will fill these roles in the future.

Pastor Brad also visited with the council about the possibility of "adopting" a congregation in the North Carolina synod that is experiencing difficulties due to hurricane Helene. He indicated this would not be in terms of a large financial commitment, but support in prayer and smaller ways such as raising money for some needed supplies or things that can help their ministry get back on its feet. Council expressed their support for this plan. Pastor will visit with Faith's Council at their upcoming meeting to see if this can be a Parish project. He will also visit with Grace Beyond Our Doors at their upcoming meeting.

**SECRETARY'S REPORT:** Don motioned to approve minutes as presented. Clem 2nd. Approved.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Brenda presented financials. General Fund giving continues to be down year-to-date. Currently, we have spent nearly \$10,000 more in general fund expenses compared to general fund giving, despite being under our approved budgeted expenses for the year. We will need to keep an eye on this as we move into the end of the year. Clem motioned to approve. Erin 2nd. Approved.

## OLD BUSINESS:

**Nominating Committee Contacts:** Pastor and Kelli gave updates on recruitment. We have one council position left (Treasurer). Kelli will connect with the nominating committee to have them work on smaller committee roles.

**Musicians: 4th Sunday Coverage:** Pastor Brad is investigating some potential leads. Kelli and Annette will connect with some musicians who have acted as subs to see if they can help out in the new year. Pastor Brad explained Hymnal Plus (an electronic musician which Faith is using some Sundays) which acts as an electronic accompanist. He will connect with Dan Olson to make sure a test run is done in case we need to utilize this option for a Sunday.

**Fall Bazaar:** Kelli reported that the Fall Bazaar was a success. It raised \$7,830.75, which was just a bit less than the previous year. Council expressed their appreciation for all of the work and donations that led up to this successful event!

**Council Retreat:** Erin will take a look at calendar and set something up for the new year.

## NEW BUSINESS:

**Congregational Meeting – Election of Officers – Date:** Congregational meeting date set for Sunday, November 24. We will be electing 2025 officers.

**Set Budget Meeting Date:** November 20 at 8 pm.

**Parish Council Meeting Update:** Eric shared some updates from the Parish Council meeting.

**Parsonage Maintenance/Repairs:** Trustees are working on some updates at the parsonage. Possibly adding a mini split system for air conditioning and some other painting/repair needs. Will have estimates prior to budget meeting.

## COMMITTEE REPORTS:

**DEACON'S REPORT:** Pastor and Don met about starting a new group "Kids Growing Older" which will be a social gathering of seniors from our congregation and community. Stay tuned as this idea starts forming!

**BOARD OF EDUCATION:** Coley coordinated a Dippin Dot fundraiser as part of BE Homecoming. Discussed Sunday School Christmas program which will be on December 15.

**TRUSTEE'S REPORT:** No additional.

**NEXT MEETING DATE:** Wednesday, November 13, 8 pm

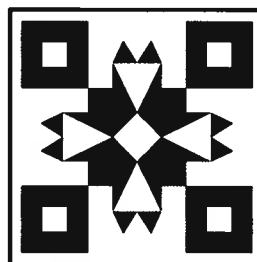
