Hours before His arrest, Jesus washes and serves.

Around the table, are twelve men – a true definition “ordinary”. Aghast their feet had been washed and told to do the same, the disciples are oblivious to the torturous pain lurking in the darkness.

When thinking about a dinner party, invitations are given to those we enjoy entertaining. For Jesus, it’s the opposite. It wasn’t about “enjoying” – it’s a sampling of a love so deep, inexpressible, it must be felt.

The One who helped create the world – from shimmering stars, lakes and farmland, to delighted 50 degree February days – now humbles Himself as servant, waiter and then breaks and pours Himself for His guests.

Jesus is both Host and Meal.

Of the invited, one betrays; another will deny; a third swims in doubt. Eight others run for cover after Jesus is arrested. Only one is courageous, bold, friend enough to stand by the cross.

Jesus knew how His dinner guests would behave and yet, it didn’t deter – it motivated.

Jesus forgave before they “behaved”.

Jesus offered mercy before it was asked.

Like the twelve, we’ve been invited. A simple meal becomes a place to “taste and see” you are forgiven; your slate is really clean; your past will never be brought up for conversation. Never!

From the meal, we go to serve as washers; feet, if need be. Washing out and away whatever is not Jesus within and around us. We do so in the spirit of gratitude without judgment.

Gratitude helps us understand, no matter what we’ve done or why, Jesus breaking and pouring Himself is one of the most beautiful ways He feasts us into forgiveness until we’re banqueting in Eternal Life.

Gratitude propels us to change for the better; to become more loving of our neighbors; and bask in awe Jesus does not, will not give up on us.

**Next Meeting:** 12 pm, March 8, 2026.





**Call to Order:** Past President Erin Okerlund called meeting to order.

**Approval of Minutes:** Minutes from January 26, 2025 were presented. No discussion. Pat Timmerman moved to approve. Terrill Morical 2nd. Approved.

**Reports:** The following letters/reports were highlighted. Bishop Tesch, Pastor's Report, Grace Council President's Report, Parish Report, Grace Beyond Our Doors, Ruth Circle and Mission Endowment Report. Members were encouraged to visit with these leaders if they would like to learn more.

Pastor Brad shared that there has been an interest in seeing more local mission activities/support from members. He has asked the council for support in making this a focus for 2026 and the Grace Council is supportive of this. Pastor would like to see the congregation do quarterly mission activities within our community/local area. This would be an intergenerational activity. Faith is looking at partnering with a local business to bring Ruby's Pantry to Evansville. They have invited Grace to participate. Pastor asked for a show of hands to see if the congregation would be interested in pursuing this. A show of hands indicated strong support. Pastor will find out more and report back to the council. He thanked the congregation for the opportunity to serve and asked if there were any areas for improvement. No feedback was received.

Judy Behlke made a motion to accept the reports; Pat Timmerman 2nd. Approved.

**Elevator Update:** Tom Behlke, Trustee reported on the status of the elevator. Upon a second opinion, it appears that we may be able to budget one-third to one-half of the expected expense for upgrades. However, the new upgrade requirements that were expected have not yet been written into law and the council will not take action until the law is implemented. We have switched over to Larson Elevator for our service agreement and will use them for any repairs/upgrades, as they have come in well under what we had been paying with Otis.

**Treasurer's Report:** Brenda Trisko, Treasurer presented the year-end report of accounts for 2025. She expressed gratitude to the congregation for their generosity in meeting a stretch budget over and above. She also thanked those serving with her on council and encouraged people to consider serving. Brenda highlighted building and general fund income and expenses. Call for any questions or discussion. Hearing none, Terrill Morical made a motion to approve the 2025 financial report. Pat Timmerman 2nd. Approved.

Noisy Offering

The Car Care Program serves Douglas, Pope, Stevens & Ottertail counties. The program was created in 2012.

The mission is to remove transportation barriers for families & individuals that need a helping hand. Whether through a repaired vehicle, a donated car or the youth training program, they exist to keep people moving forward - literally & figuratively.

Their belief is honoring God by serving their neighbors with compassion, kindness & integrity.

They invest in high school students by teaching them automotive repair through their car care elective course. They also teach automotive to the volunteers.

To date, the program has repaired over 1100 vehicles, utilizing volunteer labor. 550 vehicles have been donated since 2013.

The program now has two locations - one in Alexandria and one in Fergus Falls.

They work closely with local businesses, schools, churches & community organizations as it takes all of us to keep families thriving. Recently the program has lost a great deal of their funding.

During worship on March 8, we will welcome Chris Chisholm, Director of the Car Care Program, to share more about their mission. Please help us support this worthwhile mission.


