Those who knew of my “going into cardiac arrest” mode, jumped in to help. Unfortunately, no one offered wine or to preach. I was assured everything would be fine. Oh me, of very little, little faith!

How did I let this happen? I’ve never done this before.

With the flurry of my running around (and a quick jaunt back to the parsonage), the family remained calm. They chose to be patient and kind.

Embracing the situation, I was immediately drawn to and indebted to the family’s peaceable spirit. What could have easily been uncomfortable, became a gift of Jesus.

Every day we’re faced with choices – how we’ll respond; what we’ll say and do. Will we hit the panic button; heat the fire of frustration; or breathe soothing grace?

At the center of all the commotion was a beautiful little girl – unaware of my absent mindedness or the power of love. I have no doubt if she hears the story of her Baptism, she’ll already know how to make good choices ... her parents are the best role models!

May we learn to do the same.

One choice at a time – because we choose to love and are grateful to be forgiven.

Discussed Fall Dinner: Sunday, November 8, after worship. Menu will include soup, sandwiches and pie. Freewill donation.

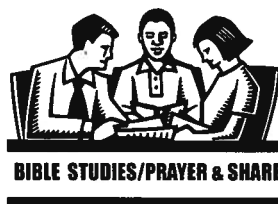
Snow removal for the upcoming season was discussed. We'll be following up with the same individuals that cleared snow last year to see if they'll be willing to do so again this year.

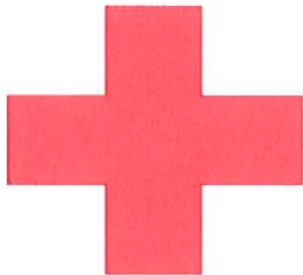

Steffen called the meeting to order. Clem motioned to approve the agenda as ammended. Tom 2nd. Approved.

VISITOR REPORTS: None

PASTORAL REPORT: Pastor Brad shared that all but one family responded to his request for input on Sunday School plans. Based upon information he received from families, we will be trying something new with "Club Bible" meeting on the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays for kids age 3 to Grade 6. 5th and 6th Graders will meet with Pastor and volunteers will work with other age groups. Confirmation orientation was this evening and went well. Discussed new points system and parents/students given expectations and important dates.

Pastor had Viking Garage Door out to repair parsonage garage doors. They recommended two other items to be completed. Clem will check it out.

Pastor will be having some people share their messages of faith during worship sometime soon.

A number of people from Grace will be helping serve for Pastor Steve's funeral.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Tina motioned to approve minutes as presented. Don 2nd. Approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Kelli presented financials. Under budgeted giving for the month. We lost headway, but are still slightly above budget year-to-date. Expenses still trending slightly under budget, was some savings with custodial position not being filled for the summer. Kelli shared that Old National Bank is wanting to charge for our dormant expense account. Steffen made a motion to close the account and move the \$250 back to General Fund in main checking account; Tom 2nd. Approved. Kelli also brought up fundraising accounts (Bazaar, Men's Dinner, Summerfest, etc.). She would like to re-organize chart of accounts before year end – will discuss at next council meeting. Don made a motion to approve Treasurer's Report. Renee 2nd. Approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

•**Rally Sunday:** Erin making rolls. Pikkaraine family serving. Tina has games and helpers ready.

•**Nominating Committee/Council Positions:** VP – Steffen Morical; Treasurer – Erin Okerlund; Deacon – Mary Burgess; Trustee – Open; Board of Ed – Open. Keep visiting with people about filling open roles. Will send to Nominating Committee soon.

•**Worship Times Survey:** Discussed the results of survey. We had 48 responses and a handful of email responses and verbal input. Decision was made to stay the course with 9 am and review later if it is not working out well. Council asked Pastor Brad to communicate if things become too challenging. If it does, then this will be re-directed to Parish Council.

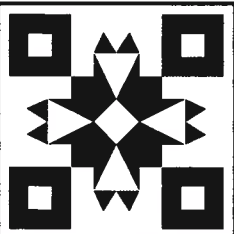

October's Noisy Offering - International Health Partners - Tanzania



Noisy
Offering

IHP- TZ provides healthcare for those that need it most in Tanzania. After turning over their last project at Zinga to local control, they have purchased land and started building a new medical center in the town of Chihoni. IHP has built an outpatient medical center and continues with other medical facilities as they raise funds. We have been supporting their work for many years and have invited the director, Paula Lofstrom and her son David West to speak to the women of the ELCA fall conference, which will be held at Grace on Oct. 24.

IHP-TZ hires and trains local residents to work at their facilities in jobs ranging from guards to nurses and Dr.'s so the projects are sustainable once all the buildings are completed. If you are interested in their work, check out their website at ihptz.org.

Their monthly newsletters give very detailed updates of their building projects and exactly how much money is needed for certain items.

Current needs are:

1. \$67,089 to finish the walls and the roof of the women and child's health building
2. \$22,500 for the anesthesia and cautery machines to do emergency C-Sections.
3. \$41,400 to finish the Eye Center, Dental Center, and Hearing Center.

They ask for your prayers and continued support to help provide medical resources to those in need.
