We're trying something new at Grace this fall. Kids 3 years old through 6th Grade will meet twice a month, on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday, 5:15 to 6 pm. Students in Grades 7-9 meet Wednesday evenings with Pastor Brad. Students will take turns serving as acolytes, readers, ushers and various service projects during the year. **Worship attendance is also a requirement of confirmation.** Other expectations will be discussed during the orientation meeting - please be sure to attend.

Pain hurts.

It's uncomfortable; can be debilitating; it tells us something's wrong.

It also teaches.

Early June, I woke up to excruciating pain on my left side. Unable to get out of bed, I was dumbstruck to what was happening. I couldn't think – all I wanted to do was "get downstairs".

Four doctors, four different opinions and several failed medications later, I'm nestled in an MRI talking with God. Keeping my eyes shut, I'm hoping somewhere between God and the machine I'll find an answer to what's making me wobble, wince, twist and turn day and night.

It's a toss up, what's more "painful" the pain or not having satisfactory, understandable answers.

Much to my surprise, when I was the most frustrated with differing opinions and asking for stronger medications, that's when pain started teaching her best lessons.

I was reminded what two childhood friends taught me. One is a doctor, another, an intensive care neo-natal nurse. What they do is the "practice of medicine". There's never a guarantee or a "for sure". Doctors don't know everything!

For all the expectations I had, I never thought to pray ahead of my visits, asking God to give my providers guidance and discernment; to watch over those working in labs, using scans, machines and checking patients in and out of their appointments.

Gratitude goes a long way. Whether it was after my vitals were taken; blood work done; after the MRI or every appointment; I made sure to say, "Thank You!" Not only is this something I need to say and write more of, but I realized gratitude is part of our health. Even when we're uncomfortable, to find someone to compliment is gift.

Pain teaches empathy – a compassion to be present without the temptation to advise that one "should do this or that". A quiet presence becomes a needed shelter. It's enough to love and listen. Oh, if we'd listen more!

My best conversations with God have been when I'm at my wit's end. When I know I'm not in the driver's seat and can never handle the steering wheel.

It's those moments I feel most at peace. I'm small enough to know my BIG God is in control. God didn't cause my pain but is using it to bless, teach and change me into a better person, husband and servant.

Pastor Brad closed the meeting with a prayer.

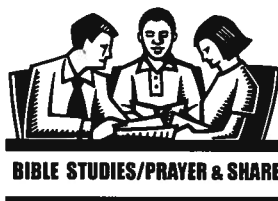

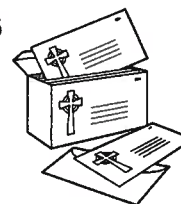

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Grace Lutheran Church Minutes - 8/12/26

Grace Members Present: Don Bakken, Tom Behlke, Steffen Morical, Tina Pikkaraine, Clem Roers, Dawson Staples

Guests Present: Pastor Bradley Pearson, Kelli Wendel



Steffen called the meeting to order. Tina motioned to approve the agenda as ammended. Dawson 2nd. Approved.

VISITOR REPORTS: None

PASTORAL REPORT: Pastor Brad shared that Faith council made the decision to keep their worship at 10:30 am year-round. This will cause there to be a shorter amount of time for Pastor Brad to transition between services. Discussion took place on the history of worship time discussions; council decided to have Kelli send out a quick survey of congregational members to see if there were strong feelings toward keeping worship at 9 am or if we should move it to 8:30 to allow the necessary time between services for travel and being available for a short amount of time for those who want/need to connect with Pastor. Kelli will send out the survey and will make calls to follow up depending upon participation. Decision will be made prior to Rally Sunday.

Pastor Brad shared with council the work he has been doing in regards to Sunday School and Confirmation Classes. A letter was sent out to the Sunday School aged families looking for their input and commitment. Only two responses so far. Pastor Brad will reach out to those who did not respond.

Changes are also planned for Confirmation Classes. He shared how he hopes these changes will help – he has been saddened and frustrated with how things have been going the past few years. This year, parents will be required to participate – this is in an effort to ensure the kids are listening and being respectful during their time in class. Pastor will no longer require worship notes, but there will be weekly assignments. Students will accrue points based upon their participation and worship attendance. There will be so many points needed to move forward on a path to getting confirmed. It is hoped that this will help with accountability in both the students and parents. These changes will be addressed as part of the orientation meeting. Tina will be working on tracking and communication with the families.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Tom motioned to approve minutes as presented. Clem 2nd. Approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Kelli presented financials. Slightly under budget in giving for the month, but nothing to be too concerned with at this time. Expenses still trending slightly under budget, was some savings with custodial position not being filled for the summer. Kelli shared some issues receiving invoices in the mail for our propane contract through CHS and asked for permission to process the balanced billing electronically instead of cutting a physical check. Don made a motion to approve automatic payments for CHS billing. Tina 2nd. Approved.

OLD BUSINESS:

•Summerfest Breakfast: Freewill offering of \$1,614.50 was received less expenses of \$927.97 (\$250 Thrivent Action Team was used to help with this) = \$891.53 raised.

•Custodian Position: Pat Timmerman has agreed to serve in this role. Tina made a motion to hire Pat for the position up to 5 hours per week. Don 2nd. Approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

•Rally Sunday: Rally Sunday will be September 13. We will have rolls and fruit for fellowship and there will be games and activities for the kids. Tina will coordinate helpers and games.

•Ideas for Nominating Committee: It is time to begin thinking of candidates for next year's council. We are in need of the following members: VP, Treasurer, Deacon, Trustee and Board of Education. Council is encouraged to visit with people who would be good in these positions to see if they are interested in serving. Nominating Committee will be getting together soon to begin calling.

•Confirmation/Youth Concerns: There were three families of confirmation aged students who contacted Steffen and Dawson with concerns and ideas for confirmation and youth programming. Discussion took place on the stated concerns and what has been taking place in the past. With the new ideas that Pastor and the Board of Education are looking to implement, it was felt that a number of these concerns were being looked at. The council affirmed their trust in Pastor Brad to provide leadership for the spiritual education of the congregation. They will continue to monitor progress with new changes throughout the year. Council also supported Pastor and the Board of Ed with more accountability among students/parents of confirmation students to meet the requirements for confirmation and that students will not be confirmed if they are not putting in the effort to meet the basic requirements.

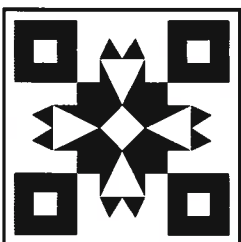

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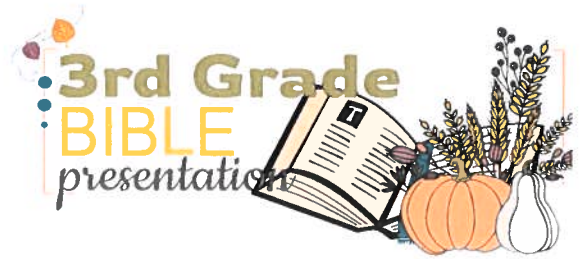
