February 9, 2025**



Next meeting is March 2 in the library following worship. All are welcome.

We opened with prayer. We will ask the church council to approve our participation in the Habitat for Humanity Faith Build taking place in Alexandria this spring. Our financial commitment of \$1500 will be shared with Faith.

Our Noisy Offering in April will be the first week instead of conflicting with Palm Sunday the second week. Noisy Offerings for the next few months will be as follows: March-Helps International (Michelle), April-Life Source with Kristi Roers (Jean), May-Habitat for Humanity Faith Build (Michelle).

Our special visitor for the meeting was Karsten Nelson, a retired pastor from the St. Paul Area Synod of the ELCA. He has a cabin in the area and has worshiped with us regularly in the past. He is involved in ministries in the Dominican Republic and Tanzania. We are interested in supporting these ministries with our Noisy Offerings and possibly as volunteers on one of his mission trips. The Tanzania project is through the St. Paul Area Synod and is a sister parish project. They are working in several different areas and are raising money for scholarships, training pastors, purchasing motorbikes for pastors to cover the long distances between churches, supplying period supplies to girls, and drilling water wells. Karsten leads immersion trips to Tanzania in November.

In the Dominican Republic, he works with the Doulos Discovery School which has been operating in the mountains for 20 years training the future leaders of the country. There are opportunities to support students and staff financially. The school is a mix of wealthy and poor students studying together. It is considered one of the top schools academically in the country and is a Christian school. Karsten will be leading a trip to visit the Doulos School next February. We will be considering both of these projects for future Noisy Offerings.

Please join us March 2 as we lift up our neighbors in Central America with our offering.

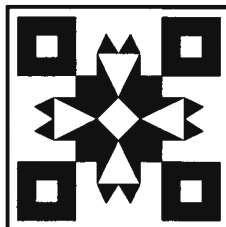
